The City of Dayton offers a "School System of Choices" with its unique and progressive Magnet Schools Program such as international studies, Montessori, computer technology/engineering, professional studies and visual & performing arts at 36 of the district's schools.

Admission

To enter Kindergarten, a child must be 5 years old on or before September 30 of the enrollment year and their parents or legal guardians must live within the School District. The successful completion of Kindergarten is a mandatory requirement for entrance into the first grade.

Admission to a magnet school program is based on applying within the designated time period, theme selection, available space and racial balance. Every attempt is made to assign students to one of the three magnet school choices indicated on the application. There is no academic admission requirement nor admission test for initial entry into any magnet program. Initial entry into a magnet program occurs at Kindergarten, Grades 1,7 and 9.

Parents of children entering the Dayton Public Schools for the first time may register through the Central Registration Office located at the Roosevelt Center, 2013 West Third Street. Parents may call 262-2973 for additional information about registration procedures.
