To enter Kindergarten, a child must be 5 years old on or before September 30 of the enrollment year and their parents or legal guardian must live within the Huber Heights City Schools District. To enter first grade, a child must be 6 years old on or before September 30 of the enrollment year or have successfully completed

one full year of public school Kindergarten.

- Immunization/vaccine records
